

Special Conditions for Registering Reserved Domain Names

Last updated on 25 July 2021

The purpose of this document is to specify special conditions for registering reserved Domain Names as per clause 3.2.5 of the GE Domain Registration and Administration Rules (the “**Domain Regulation**”).

1. List of Reserved Domain Names

1.1 Country names

- (i) The country names are reserved for registration by the embassy or consulate of the corresponding country;
- (ii) An authorized representative of the country (an embassy, consulate or the equivalent) may apply to the Registrar for registering reserved Domain Name.

1.2 Names of all cities and administrative entities, rivers, lakes of Georgia

- (i) The names of all cities, administrative entities, rivers, lakes of Georgia are reserved for registration for the respective local government or authorized person.

1.3 Telephone codes

- (i) All Domain Names which are comprised of numerals and are similar to the telephone codes shall be reserved for the respective holders of the telephone code.

1.4 Domain Names that are not available for registration

- (i) Domain Names which are not available for registration and are reserved due to cybersecurity purposes considering recommendations of governmental bodies, stakeholders.

1.5 The complete list of reserved Domain Names is published on the webpage of the Registry. The list contains Domain Names that are available for registration, Domain Names that are already registered under the name of the Registrant and Domain Names that are not available for registration.

2. Conditions for Registering Reserved Domain Names

2.1 The Registrant wishing to register a reserved Domain Name, except for the Domain Name which is not available for registration, shall submit an application to the Registrar which application among other requirements established for the registration of the Domain Name shall include materials substantiating the right to register the relevant reserved Domain Name.

2.2 The Registrant shall be responsible for the authenticity of the data presented in the application and must notify the Registrar of changes in the said data within 7 (seven) business days by submitting the respective electronic application.

2.3 The Registrar shall verify the conformity of the data submitted upon registration of a reserved Domain Name to the conditions for registration of reserved Domain Names and if the

application meets the requirements for registering reserved Domain Name shall forward such application to the Registry.

- 2.4 If the registration period for the registered reserved Domain Name expires, the registrant is allowed to register the reserved Domain Name again following the rules provided in this document, except for the Domain Name which is not available for registration.
