Rules for Processing Personal Data

1. The Registrar is entitled to process personal data related to the Domain Names on the basis of the Contract and the Domain Regulation, and only for the purposes and in accordance with the term as provided in the Domain Regulation and Contract. This Annex constitutes integral part of the Contract.
2. The Registrar agrees and undertakes to ensure confidentiality of personal data and use such personal data only for the purposes of performing the functions and liabilities of the registrar.
3. The Registrar shall be entitled to authorize subcontractors to process personal data only with the prior written consent of the Registry.
4. The Registrar shall ensure the compliance of the procedures for collection and processing of personal data with the applicable laws and reflect such procedure in the Registrar's internal regulations.
5. The Registrar shall provide the available personal data to the Registry immediately upon request.
6. The Registrar shall employ the necessary organizational and technical measures to ensure security of personal data. For these purposes, the Registrar shall assume the liability to:
 - 6.1 Oblige its employees to comply with the existing requirements and the relevant procedure of personal data protection;
 - 6.2 Use such information technology for the processing of personal data that ensures data security against accidental or illegal destruction, alteration, disclosure, collection, and any kind of illegal use or accidental or illegal loss;
 - 6.3 Use preventive measures to secure personal data against damage or unauthorized access by third parties.
7. The Registry shall be entitled to monitor the Registrar's compliance with the terms stipulated in the Contract, Domain Regulation and the laws of Georgia, and inspect the process and rules of personal data protection implemented by the Registrar.
8. In case of termination of the Contract, the Registrar shall be liable to discontinue processing of personal data on behalf of the Registry, fully transfer the available personal data to the Registry, and remove such data from its system and database.
